

Preventing initial vocational education and training dropouts by trainees in the European Context



The project “In-VET – Preventing initial VET dropouts and fostering trainee’s inclusion”, an initiative supported by the European Commission, joints partners from Portugal, Spain, Italy, Austria and Germany sharing a common goal: contribute to the reduction of the dropout-rate in the initial vocational education and training (VET) systems. In detail, In-VET will develop an online toolkit for iVET managers, trainers/trainers, tutors and counselors, which will include a risk assessment tool, training materials for trainers and teachers to tackle with the dropout problem as well as a set of complementary materials and networking actions.

The main focus is on the need of reducing the actual rates of earlier leavers to 10% by 2020, through the promoting of the development and consolidation of skills of iVET professionals, allowing them, for one hand, to identify at an early stage the trainees at risk of dropping out and, on other hand, to design and implement suitable strategies to prevent this phenomenon.
